Title	<b>Aesthetic Choices and Political Issues - Multilingual Literary Writing in Romance Languages</b>
Short description by the host university	<p>In today's world, many political tensions and conflicts are leading to increased migration. These migrations impact on all strata of society, and as a result many writers find themselves far from their native country and their mother tongue. Many of them become plurilingual writers, choosing the idiom of the host country as a means of expression, but literary plurilingualism can also be the result of a purely aesthetic choice.</p> <p>During the previous BIP on Plurilingual Romance Language Authors in April 2022 and the subsequent scientific meetings of the research network, two aspects of this literary plurilingual writing</p>

emerged: on the one hand, free aesthetic choice and, on the other, the numerous political constraints. It is therefore around these two poles that the new BIP will be articulated to allow - on a scientific level - to dig deeper into this field of investigation.

In the context of European citizenship and UNITA, a multilingual experience is undoubtedly a formative and valuable experience; this BIP will allow master's and doctoral students from at least six nations to meet and exchange on the issues of pluri- and multilingualism for a high intensity intercultural exchange, while having the possibility to analyse fundamental aspects of it. As this BIP is coorganised by several partners of the UNITA alliance, it becomes obvious to focus on Romance language.

Short description by the host university	The event “UVT Green Month – Innovation and Entrepreneurship in the European Blue Economy” is organized by the West University of Timișoara and takes place in April-May 2023. This year's edition

	<p>is follow-up to the 6th annual event, which has been previously selected as EU Green Week 2021 &amp; 2022 - Partner event.</p> <p>The central theme of this spring edition is dedicated to innovation and entrepreneurship in blue economy, specifically taking into consideration that the West University of Timișoara has developed a working group dedicated to the integration of the European Green Deal with respect to blue economy, in co-creation with regional and national partners, as well as with partners from European University Alliances.</p> <p>The event also includes a Blended Intensive Learning Programme (BIP) dedicated to the UNITA – Universitas Montium community. The BIP takes place between 24th of April 2023 – 12th of May 2023 and is organized based on an open innovation model, involving all stakeholders representative for the quadruple helix model. Innovation and entrepreneurship is viewed as a vehicle to achieve consumer readiness for blue economy solutions.</p> <p>The virtual component will include virtual plenary sessions on blue economy topics and ideathon sessions, benefitting from mentorship with representatives of all stakeholder categories included in the quadruple helix innovation model.</p> <p>The in person component will include plenary sessions, workshops and hackathon sessions for the development of concrete solutions aimed at enhancing the European dimension of blue economy for ideas best awarded and jury selected after the virtual ideathon. Title	<b>Randopat-Heritrail 2: sur les Chemins de Roland</b>
Short description by the host university	This summer school will allow its participants to (re)discover Pyrenean landscapes in the light of Mediaeval works. It will include the presentation of literary excerpts, the comparison of different points of view on the legend of Roland, the transcription and translation of excerpts from Mediaeval manuscripts/texts, reading out or singing Mediaeval texts. Title	<b>Summer School: Green Business in Europe, Managing resilience and sustainability in Europe</b>
Short description by the host university	The current shift to more sustainable economic systems is challenging, but it offers a variety of opportunities and pathways for designing a professional career. Companies that anticipate the necessary changes and adapt in a timely manner will likely be the winners of this century. This summer school aims to provide future managers with the necessary skills to

start and run green businesses, with an intercultural and European approach ([www.univ-unita.eu](http://www.univ-unita.eu)). The EMBS programme (<https://embs.eu/>) is an existing master programme at USMB with a multicultural pedagogical approach. It is now expanding its offer: we invite students to participate in this summer school, which offers an improvement of skills desirable by any company wishing to compete in an international market and in a green innovation economy. Students will have to design a project proposal, study or start-up on the subject of the summer school "Managing resilience and sustainability in Europe", consistent with two of the UNITA Project themes (renewable energies, circular economy) in the multicultural framework of EMBS extended to UNITA, in line with the third UNITA Project theme (cultural heritage). Classes, workshops, student presentations with feedback from the EMBS/UNITA team will be offered in English. In the middle of the week, a roundtable discussion with local companies from the USMB chair on environmental economics and a hike with informal exchanges will complete the students' experience.

#### Program

Title	<b>Energy communities in mountain village</b>
Short description by the host university	Summer School “Energy communities in mountain villages” is a summer course with lectures, field trip and project work covering basic knowledge of various topics regarding the different energy production techniques (i.e. solar-photovoltaics, hydroelectric, geothermal, wind, bio); energy storage approach (e.g. pumping, batteries, hydrogen as an energy carrier); social aspects related to the development of energy communities. A field trip to the isolated villages in Cerna Valley in romanian Carpathian mountains and visits to local plants for renewable energies management will be also organized.

The focus will be on renewable energy technologies that can be a convenient and economically feasible option in isolated communities. The summer school will be held in Timisoara (Romania) for 5 days, from July 10th to July 14th, 2023. The school will be carried out in the Erasmus frame, and it will be delivered in English. Master students will be engaged on a multidisciplinary basis. 20 students are expected in total, from UNITA Universities.
