





## FAQ UNITA ERASMUS BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME How to fill in the Learning Agreement

## 1. How to fill in the Learning Agreement?

If you are selected for a BIP mobility, you have to fill in the Learning Agreement document, which is available in the "Attachments" section, located in the left column of the <a href="Erasmus Blended">Erasmus Blended</a> <a href="Intensive Programme web">Intensive Programme web</a> site.

Before you leave, you need to fill in the "Before the Mobility" section, by indicating:

- in the first table (page 1): your personal details and those of the host university;
- <u>in table A:</u> the details of the BIP for which you have been selected (title and credits awarded)
- <u>in table B</u>: details relating to the activity for which you will apply for BIP recognition in your career plan (activity code, title and recognised credits);
- in the "Commitment" section, you will have to sign.

The Learning Agreement must be approved before the mobility and signed by your <u>Didactic</u> <u>Responsible for the Mobility of your Course of Study</u> in accordance with the teaching regulations and curricula and/or the Doctoral School.

Once the document has been approved and signed, you can send it to unita.students@unito.it in order to ask for the signature of the host university.

## 2. For which activities can I apply for recognition of BIP mobility credits?

In order for a Blended Intensive Programme to be recognised in your study plan, the activity included in the Learning Agreement must have a number of ETCS corresponding to the credits provided by the BIP. Please note that you have until **May**, **30**<sup>th</sup> **2025** to change your study plan. More information on the Study Plan website.







You can apply for recognition of:

- 1. **Curricular exam**, if it is coherent in terms of ECTS and scientific field with the activities you will carry out during the mobility. If you choose this option, you need to be sure that the BIP in which you will participate in will award a grade at the end of the experience.
- 2. **Free credits or optional activities** (e.g. "other activities" or "training activities abroad" or "laboratory") which do not necessarily require a grade, but can be recognised by simply by passing the training activity with any associated suitability assessment.
- 3. **Credits for 'Blended Intensive Programme'** as part of Free Choice Examinations TAF D, available for those who have the option to include 'Free Choice Activities' in their career plan. Before including 'Blended Intensive Programme' in the learning agreement, please check that you can include it in your career plan.

The entry is associated with the following courses:

- Bachelor's degree in Herbal Products;
- Master's Degree in Environmental Chemistry;
- 5-year single-cycle degree in Conservation and Restoration of Cultural Heritage;
- 6-year single-cycle degree in Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics.

4. Extra credits (outside the study plan): if you have reached the maximum number of free credits foreseen by your degree programme, you can recognise the BIP with any activity (e.g. specific courses or 'other activities' or 'Blended Intensive Programme' entries) offered by the University of Turin that is consistent in terms of the number of credits with your BIP. This type of activity will not be included in your final career average grade. If you choose this option, you must check with the Student Secretariat on the possibility of obtaining additional credits.
