How to fill in the Learning Agreement

1. How to fill in the Learning Agreement for Studies

If you have been selected for a virtual mobility, you have to fill in the **Learning Agreement document**, which is available in the "Attachments" section, located in the left column of the [UNITA Virtual Mobility page](#). You have to indicate:

- In the first table (page 1): your personal details and those of the host university;
- in Table A: the details of the Virtual course for which you have been selected (title and credits awarded);
- In table B: details relating to the activity for which you will ask for recognition in your career plan (activity code, title and recognised credits);
- in the "Commitment" section, your signature and the signature of [your Degree Programme's Academic Coordinator for Student Mobility](#).

The Learning Agreement must be approved before the mobility and signed by [your Degree Programme's Academic Coordinator for Student Mobility](#) before the start of the course, following the provisions of the academic regulations and study plans and/or the Doctoral School. Once the document has been approved and signed, you can **send it to unita.students@unito.it**

2. For which activities can I apply for recognition of Virtual mobility credits?

To recognise a Virtual course in your study plan, the activity included in the Learning Agreement must have a number of ETCS corresponding to the credits provided by the virtual course.

Please note that you have until May, 30th 2026 to change your study plan. More information on the [Study Plan website](#).

You may request recognition of:

- Curricular exam from your study plan, if it is consistent in terms of ECTS credits and scientific field with the course you will attend through virtual mobility;
- Elective educational activities or Free credits (e.g., "Other activities," "Training activity abroad," "Laboratory," etc.) that do not necessarily require a grade but can be recognized by the mere completion of the training activity, possibly with a pass/fail evaluation;
- Credits for the Flexibility Window within the scope of free elective exams (TAF D). In this case, indicate "Flexibility window" in Table B under the field Component title at the Sending Institution, and specify the number of ECTS credits granted by the chosen course. You may include these entries only if your study plan includes free elective courses;
- Additional free credits exceeding the standard number: if you have already reached the maximum number of free credits allowed by your degree program, you may include any activity (e.g., specific courses, "Other activities," or the "Flexibility window") offered by the University of Turin that matches the credit value of the selected course. Any grade obtained in this additional activity will not be counted toward your final grade average.
