How to fill in the Learning Agreement

1. How to fill in the Learning Agreement? (for international mobility only)

If you are selected for a Rural mobility abroad, you have to fill in the Learning Agreement document. Before you leave, you need to fill in the "**Before the Mobility**" section, by indicating:

- in the first table (page 1): your personal details and those of the sending university;
- in table B: the way in which Rural Mobility activities will be recognised in your study path;
- in the "Commitment" section, you will have to sign the document as trainee.

The Learning Agreement must be approved before the mobility and signed by the [Didactic Responsible for the Mobility of your Course of Study](#) in accordance with the teaching regulations and curricula and/or the Doctoral School.

Once the document has been approved and signed, you can send it to the host institution in order to ask for the signature of the *responsible person at the receiving institution*.

2. For which activities can I apply for recognition of Rural mobility?

Please note that you have until **May, 30th 2025** to change your study plan. More information on the [Study Plan website](#).

You can apply for recognition of:

1. **Internship**, if it is coherent with your course of study and in terms of ECTS with the activities you will carry out during the rural mobility.
2. Credits for "**UNITA Rural Mobility**", available as part of the free-choice activities (TAF D). This option can be selected by students who have the opportunity to include 'free activities from the academic offer' in their career plan within TAF D.

The entries “UNITA Rural Mobility” (from 1 to 6 ECTS) are associated with the following courses:

- Bachelor's degree in Herbal Products;
- Master's Degree in Environmental Chemistry;
- 5-year single-cycle degree in Conservation and Restoration of Cultural Heritage;
- 6-year single-cycle degree in Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics.
