

CALL FOR AWARDING 10 SCHOLARSHIPS "UNITO FOR STUDENTS AT RISK" FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS a.y. 2024-2025

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. Can candidates with a foreign qualification enroll at the university?

It is possible to enroll in an Italian university, in an undergraduate degree or a 5-6-year postgraduate degree, if you hold a qualification (secondary school diploma or equivalent) obtained after **12 years of schooling**, providing that this guarantees access, in the foreign educational system of reference, to a degree program equivalent to the Italian one in which the candidate wishes to enroll. In addition, the qualification allows access to an Italian university if obtained after attending at least the last two years in the same foreign education system. If you have obtained a foreign upper secondary school diploma after **11** or **10** overall years of education, this qualification does not allow access to Italian universities unless you integrate the missing year(s).

If a mandatory national entrance exam is required in your country to enroll in university, the same exam may also be required for admission to Italian universities, so make sure you attach it to your online application.

PLEASE NOTE: The evaluation of the foreign qualification (upper secondary school diploma or 1st level university qualification) is **compulsory** and must be carried out by the International Students Office on the Apply@Unito platform.

4. I am eligible for the undergraduate program (3-year program). What do I have to do now?

If you want to enroll in an undergraduate degree program with free admission, you must sit the Minimum Requirements Assessment Test (TARM), delivered through the CISIA TOLC. If you obtain or have already obtained a score lower than the thresholds that will be established, you will still be able to enroll but you will be assigned an Additional Educational Obligation (OFA) defined by each degree program. For enrollment in the academic year 2024-2025 the TOLCs taken from January 1st 2023 to October 10th 2024 are valid. You can take the test at any Italian university available.

- Register for the competition for the undergraduate degree programs chosen by 15th October 2024, 3 pm by going to your MyUniTo personal page, following the path "Enrollment" (top left) - "Preenrolment for free admission courses" and selecting the corresponding grouping.

Based on the course you want to matriculate in and for which you took the TOLC test, **pre-enrol in one of the 5 groups** established by UniTo:

- **Group 1 (TOLC-E)** programs in: Amministrazione aziendale; Economics and statistics for organizations and Economics (Economia)
- **Group 2 (TOLC-S)** programs in: Chemistry and chemical technology; Physics; Computer Science; Mathematics; Mathematics for finance and insurance; Materials science; Earth Sciences; Natural Sciences; Herbal products, Chemistry for Sustainable Manufacturing and Optics and Optometry
- Group 3 (TOLC-SU) programs in: Cultural heritage; Cross-cultural communication; Labour consultancy and human resources management; Modern Cultures and Literatures; DAMS (Music, Performing arts, Cinema and New Media); Agricultural and food law; Legal Sciences for firms and institutions; Philosophy; Law (Turin and Cuneo); Humanities; Languages and cultures of Asia and Africa; Languages and cultures for tourism; Modern languages and literatures; Communication



Studies; Modern Languages; Digital administration studies; Political & social sciences; Social work (Biella); History

- Group 4 (English TOLC-E) program in: Global law and transnational legal studies
- **Group 5 (TOLC-AV)** programs in: Agricultural science and technology; Forestry and Environmental Sciences; Science and technology for mountains; Sustainability of Animal Production Systems and Food technology.
- **Group 6 TOLC-SPS**: Social Innovation, communication, new Technologies International Science, Development and Cooperation -, Political & Social Sciences

Missing the registration deadline to the UniTo grouping will prevent you from enrolling in the chosen degree program.

Additional information on the OFA will be provided in the upcoming months.

5. I am eligible for a postgraduate degree program. What do I have to do now?

6. I have read the call, but some definitions are not clear.

APPLY@UNITO: Application platform for the evaluation of foreign qualifications;

APPLICATION: submitting study documentation on a platform dedicated to the evaluation of foreign qualifications, aimed at finding out if your foreign qualification allows you to enroll in an undergraduate or 5/6-year postgraduate degree program or a postgraduate degree program;

FOREIGN QUALIFICATIONS COMMITTEE: the board of professors that assesses your study documents to establish if you meet admission and language requirements and you have an adequate personal knowledge for the access of the chosen postgraduate degree program;

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD COMMITTEE: selection commission for this call for applications for the award of 10 scholarships;

TERRITORIAL COMMISSION: The Territorial Commission for the recognition of international protection, established at the "Prefettura" - Territorial Office of the Government; is the competent authority for examining applications for international protection, previously formalized at the Border Police Offices or at the Police Headquarters;

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM (3-year program): Undergraduate degree program which issues a first level academic qualification. <u>The admission qualification is the upper secondary school diploma;</u>



POSTGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM: two-year degree program that issues a II level academic qualification (master's degree). <u>The admission qualification is a first level academic qualification</u> (undergraduate degree); it is not necessary to take the TARM (TOLC);

POSTGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM WITH FREE ADMISSION: Postgraduate degree program that does not require an admission test and does not have a limited quota of places. It requires the assessment of the possession of the curricular requirements and the adequacy of personal preparation by the program commission;

UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE PROGRAM WITH FREE ADMISSION: Undergraduate/single-cycle postgraduate degree program that does not require an admission test and does not have a limited quota of places. It requires the TARM (provided through TOLC); if the score is lower than the thresholds established by the various degree programs, you can still enroll but you will be assigned an Additional Educational Obligation (OFA) defined by each degree program;

EQPR: European Qualification Passport for Refugees issued by the Council of Europe. It is a document that contains the assessment of the academic qualifications of refugees who have completed a secondary school or university qualification but who do not have the relevant documentation with them to prove it. The European Refugee Qualification Passport also contains information on the individual's work experience and language skills.

OFA: Additional Educational Obligation. Additional courses that students enrolled in undergraduate degree programs or 5-6-year postgraduate degree programs with free admission must attend if the score is lower than the thresholds established for the TARM (TOLC). At the end of the course, the student must take the final exam and has time to pass it until the end of the first academic year;

TARM: test to assess the minimum requirements required by Italian legislation in order to verify that the candidate for the undergraduate degree programs or single-cycle postgraduate degree programs with free admission has the minimum requirements required to access the chosen degree program; at the University of Turin the TARM is delivered through TOLC TEST; **it is not needed** to access to postgraduate degrees with free admission.

TOLC TEST: the typology of the test you have to take to meet the admission requirement of the TARM; the test takes place on the <u>CISIA</u> platform.
