Generative AI is being incorporated into professional practices and craft in areas including marketing, journalism, graphic design, writing, videogames, and translation, impacting on the life and work of individuals working in these industries. What are the opportunities and challenges faced by the present and aspiring professionals in these fields? How should educational institutions, including universities, help ensure that students and instructors are placed in the position to explore and reflect on the benefits and potential risks of the changes sparked by these technologies?
