Title of the research project	<i>Personality Assessment, Psychopathology, and Malingering</i>				
Description of the research project	<i>The current research project aims at testing new methods and approaches to detect malingering of mental disorders. More specifically, we intend to test the validity and utility of a new malingering tool, i.e., the Inventory of Problems, while also inspecting the possibility to use reaction times to refine its ability to discriminate between bona-fide vs. feigned psychological symptoms. Both clinical comparison, simulation studies and known groups comparisons will be considered for this research project.</i>				
Profile Description	<i>The successful candidate will have experience in personality assessment, as evidenced by his or her publications record, and experience in the field of psychopathology and malingering.</i>				
Research objectives	<i>The major goal of this research collaboration is to advance our knowledge in the field of personality assessment, psychopathology, and malingering. Moreover, we intend to develop new statistical procedures to investigate the relationship between malingering of mental disorders and reaction times (e.g., by testing curvilinear relationships).</i>
