List of exemptions from the online application procedure on Apply@UniTo for the academic year 2025-2026

(v01, 26/11/2024)

- The following are exempt from the online application procedure on Apply@UniTo for the academic year 2025-2026:
 - applicants holding a foreign study qualification who wish to enrol in the University of Turin within the framework of a mobility project aiming to obtain a **double or joint degree**;
 - applicants holding a foreign study qualification who wish to <u>transfer from another Italian</u> <u>University or wish to change degree program within the University</u>;
 - applicants holding a foreign study qualification who were **previously enrolled** in the University of Turin **in a first cycle degree program**, with their academic career regularly closed;
 - applicants holding a foreign study qualification, regularly enrolled for the academic year 2025-2026 in a degree program at an Italian University, who wish to enrol into a second degree program at the University of Turin, in <u>two contemporaneous enrolments</u>;
 - applicants holding an ecclesiastical undergraduate degree (Baccalaureate), issued by the Facoltà di Scienze dell'Educazione dell'Università Pontificia Salesiana through the Istituto Universitario Salesiano Torino Rebaudengo (IUSTO), who wish to apply for a postgraduate degree program. These applicants will have to follow the standard enrolment procedure for applicants holding an Italian academic degree. However, they will still have to submit their ecclesiastical undergraduate degree provided with proof of authenticity (called vidimazione) to the International Students Desk, in order to finalize their enrolment;
 - applicants holding a foreign study qualification previously enrolled in <u>single courses</u> at the University of Turin; the single courses must belong to a degree program of the same level (I or II) as the degree program the applicant is enrolling in;
 - students enrolled in the Foundation programme (60 CFU) at the University of Turin, whose foreign study qualification has already been positively evaluated by the International Students Desk, who have completed the entire curriculum (or will complete it within the enrolment deadline for the a. y. 2025-2026), including the final exam. In order to finalize their enrolment, they will still have to submit their foreign study qualification (provided with proof of authenticity) to the International Students Desk;
 - applicants holding a foreign study qualification who applied for an <u>academic recognition</u> of their foreign degree at the University of Turin for the a. y. 2025-2026, who wish to enrol in the degree program they aim to get recognized (should they obtain a partial recognition);
 - applicants holding a foreign study qualification who wish to enrol into one of the following degree programs with national admission: Medicine and Surgery, Medicina e Chirurgia, Medicina Veterinaria, Odontoiatria e Protesi Dentaria.

- The following are exempt from the payment of the application fee, (but not from the online application procedure on Apply@UniTo) for the academic year 2025-2026:
 - applicants holding a foreign study qualification and a residence permit for **asylum status**, **subsidiary protection**, **temporary protection** Ucraine Emergency according to *Direttiva UE* 2001/55/CE, del DPCM 28 marzo 2022 and *Legge 30 dicembre 2023*, *n. 213*, art. 395, and for **complementary protection** according to *Decreto Legislativo 28 gennaio 2008*, *n. 25*, art. 18 (protezione sociale), 18-bis (vittime di violenza domestica), 32, comma 3.
