Mathematical formula for converting final marks of foreign high school diplomas

Any mark with decimal number should be rounded to nearest

$$\text{mark} = \frac{V - V_{\min}}{V_{\max} - V_{\min}} * (I_{\max} - I_{\min}) + I_{\min}$$

V= final mark gained abroad

V_{min}= Minimum mark for promotion according to the foreign system

V_{max}= Maximum mark according to the foreign system

I_{min}= Minimum mark for promotion according to Italian schools (= 60/100)

I_{max}= Maximum mark according to Italian schools (=100/100)

Assessing evaluations based on qualitative scales, reference is made to the following conversion scale:

evaluation	Italian mark
A	100
B	90
C	80
D	70
E	60

If the diploma does not report any final mark, it will be considered as the minimum Italian mark (60/100).
