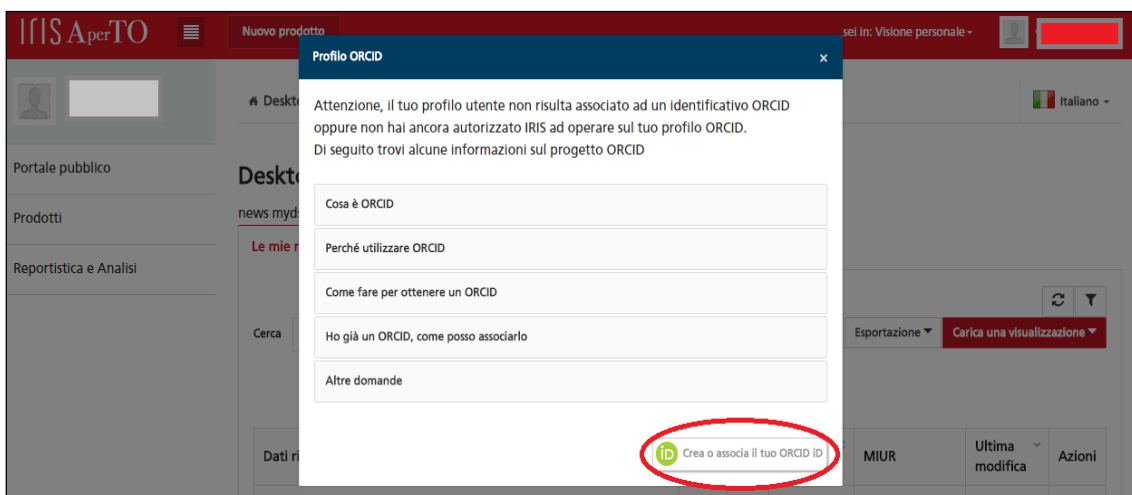




## Registration of an ORCID iD through the local research information system IRIS

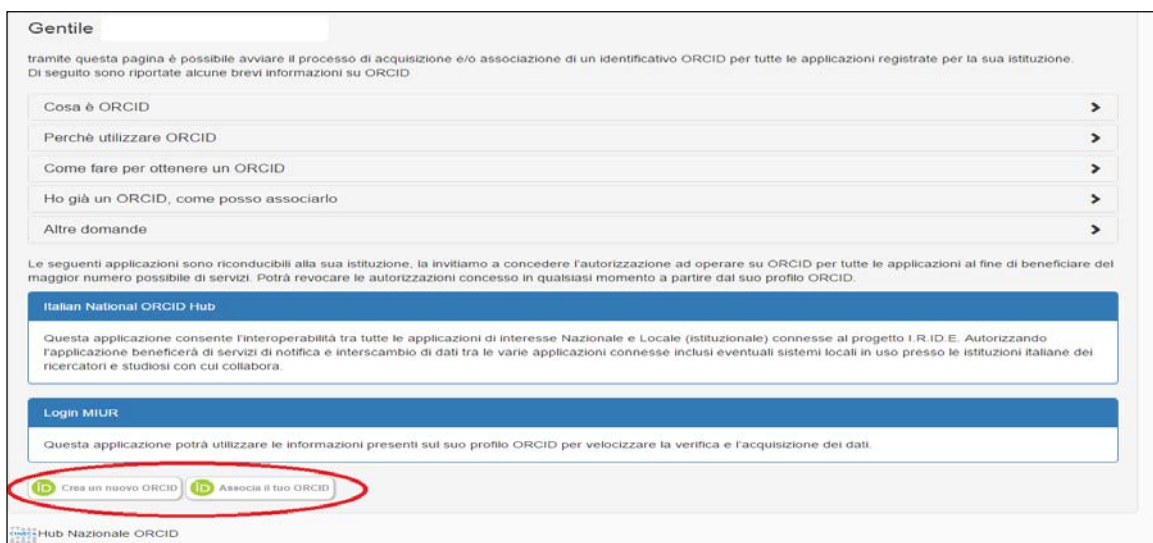
ANVUR (National Agency for the Evaluation of the University and Research Systems) set up I.R.ID.E (Italian Researcher IDentifier for Evaluation) project in order to provide all Italian researchers with an ORCID (Open Researcher and Contributor ID) iD. The use of ORCID iD helps researchers to connect to their products regardless of the subject area or national boundaries.

1. In order to obtain an ORCID iD, or associate it to an existing account, researchers should use the authentication interface on [IRIS](#) (Institutional Research Information System) local service. After logging in with their SCU username, users can proceed by clicking on the button **Create or Associate your ORCID iD** (Picture 1).

2. Users can now proceed to create a new account by clicking on the button **Create a new ORCID** or associate the existing one with local ([IRIS](#)) and national ([LoginMIUR](#)) research information system, by clicking on the button **Associate your ORCID** (Picture 2).

3a. **For users without an ORCID iD:** users should fill in the registration form with required information and set a password to create a new ORCID account, by clicking on the button **Authorize** (Picture 3). (In case users have already registered, the system will suggest that they sign in with their ORCID username).

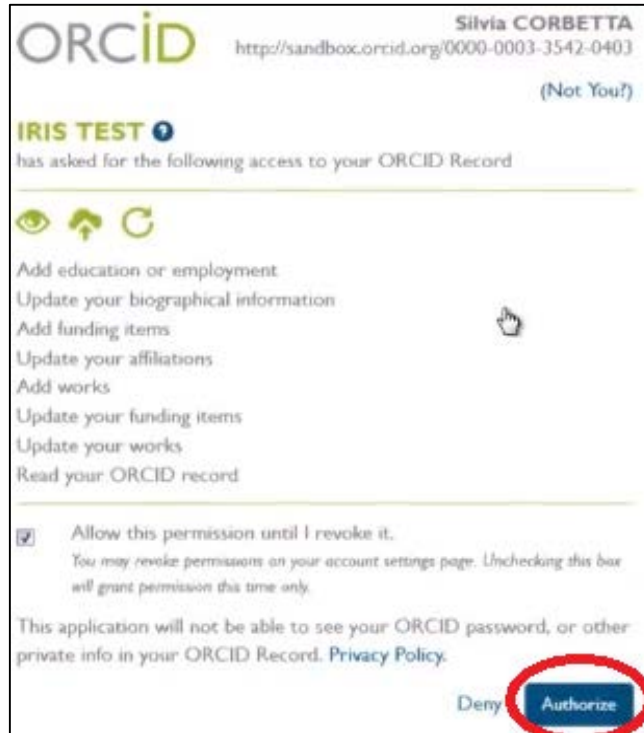

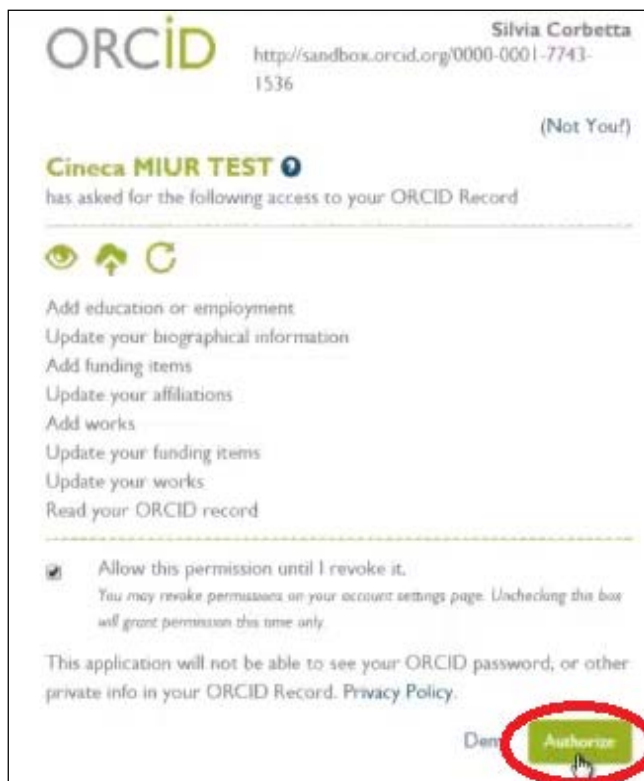

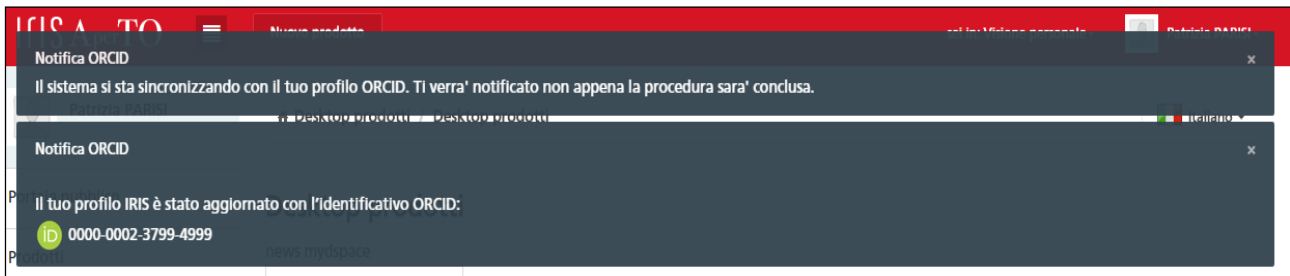
