



If you miss to go to Office Infopoint before going away, our Office will consider <u>the date of your last taken exam as</u> <u>the ending date of your mobility period</u> at our University.

TRANSCRIPT OF RECORDS

IMPORTANT: This is a <u>single</u> final document also including the *declaration of stay* and the *Italian course declaration of attendance*

At the end of the mobility period, if students' online examinations Record Book is complete (all the exams marks have been registered), the Transcript of Records is sent by e-mail to students' home Universities within about 5 weeks.



Buddy System



The buddy system is a peer-to peer service offered by Unito students to foreign students. Unito buddy students are a first connection point between foreign students and the University of Torino giving practical help and advice for various issues (i.e. arrival procedures, finding University offices, **Professors' offices, lecture halls, giving some** help in finding lessons timetable etc...)

- Signature and stamp by your Italian Coordinator (or by Erasmus Delegate of the Department)

IMPORTANT

Before taking exams students MUST always:

1. Upload their APPROVED Learning Agreement onto the online <u>career plan</u>

2. Register online for the exams through the correct procedure

If students do not upload their learning agreement and do not apply online for exams, exams grades cannot be registered by Professors and cannot be present in the final Transcript of Records at the end of the study period

<u>Online career Plan</u> (Piano carriera)

The online career plan is not available yet When it is available, students will be informed by e-mail There will be a time frame during which it

will be possible to fill in the online career

plan.



So, for each exam it is <u>COMPULSORY</u> to:

1. Upload the exam onto the online career plan during the allowed period (instructions available at "How to fill in the Career Plan for incoming students": http://en.unito.it/international-relations/students-mobility/erasmus-andexchange-students),

2. Register ONLINE for the specific date of the exam you want to take (APPELLO)

Respect the fixed period to apply for exams <u>NOTE: SHORT PERIOD TO APPLY!</u>

2. ONLINE grades registration

Exams grades can be accepted/rejected: -as for oral exams, at the moment of the exam -as for written exams automatic acceptance; refuse ONLINE within short period established by the Professor (usually 5 days)

-Automatic e-mail is sent to <u>user@edu.unito.it</u> (NOT to private email!)

- 40 hours course
- > 3 levels:



- Beginner (with one intensive course*)
- Intermediate
- Advanced

*an elementary level of the italian language is advised to attend Intensive course

Italian language course

- Courses Schedule sent by email and published on <u>http://en.unito.it/international-relations/students-mobility/erasmus-and-exchange-students</u>
 - ! Only for intermediate and advanced levels! A mandatory language test in the first day of attendance is required
- Minimum 30 mandatory lessons hours
- Final exam 5 ECTS credits, if recognized by your University
