Test for the Assessment of Minimum Requirements (TARM – TOLC)

What is it?

It's a test used to assess the prior knowledge of Italian/English language of the candidate according to the program he/she is enrolled in

Is it a selective test? **NO!** But it is **mandatory** in order to enrol

What happens if I don't pass the test?

You will be assigned an Additional Educational Obligation (OFA)

Test for the Assessment of Minimum Requirements (TARM) dedicated to international students

Applicants are not required to pass an admission exam in order to enrol in a program without a fixed quota of places, but **they must sit a minimum requirements assessment test (TARM),** provided through the **TOLC test** of CISIA. The TOLC is a non selective test, but it is **mandatory** and it is used to assess the prior knowledge of the candidate. **Different TOLC tests correspond to different degree programs.**

If you do not obtain the minimum score required, you will be able to complete your enrolment, but you will be assigned an OFA according to your citizenship and the course you are enrolling in.

Additional Educational Obligation (OFA) ** for Italian-taught undergraduate degree programs' applicants only

If you do not obtain the minimum score required you will be assigned one of the following OFA:

International candidates	Candidates with Italian citizenship or double citizenship
OFA: Italian language course requiring to pass a <u>final</u> <u>test. You have time to pass it until the end of the</u> <u>academic year (September 30th, 2022)</u> . If you do not pass the test, your career will be blocked and you won't be able to keep studying in UniTo. Alternatively, candidates can provide a B2 level, or higher, Italian language Proficiency Certificate issued by: University for Foreigners of Perugia, University for Foreigners of Siena, Rome Tre University and the Dante Alighieri Society.	OFA: you will be assigned the OFA selected by the degree program of your choice . Information on the contents and on the regulations of this additional requirement will be published on the degree program website.

OFA: English language course requiring to pass a final test. You have time to pass it until the end of the academic year (September 30th, 2022).

If you do not pass the test, your career will be blocked and you won't be able to keep studying in UniTo.

The language course will be offered by the University of Turin, starting around November and it is **free of charge.

After deadlines for enrolment, you'll receive an email with details on the course.

Are your going to enroll? Pay attention to the deadlines!



- Check the deadlines for enrolment and **make sure to respect them!** If you fail, you won't be able to complete your enrollment.
- Enrol online and pay the enrolment fee by following the dedicated guidelines published on <u>Internationals</u> <u>Students webpage</u>. Also a video-tutorial is available!
- If you are facing problems in your enrolment procedures, <u>book an online appointment</u> with a fellow buddy student! He/she will guide you through the correct procedure.

<u>Warning</u>: to book a meeting you'll need to sign in with a Google account.

The **buddy service** is available starting from September 8th 2021, every **Monday** (2:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.), **Wednesday** and **Thursday** (10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.).

For Undergraduate and for 5/6 year postgraduate degree without restricted number of places



- 1. Register on Unito (if you already did it in the past year, use past credentials*)
- 2. Pre-register by clicking on *Iscrizioni* (Enrollments) in the upper left menu and then the item *Pre-iscrizione ai corsi ad accesso libero* (Pre-enrolment for free admission) by **October 5th 2021.** For detailed information, please check <u>this webpage</u>
- 3. Login your MyUnito > menu "Enrolments" > "Matriculation" > online procedure to be completed by following the <u>dedicated tutorial</u>
- Once you have completed your pre-enrolment, you will be blocked and you won't be able to proceed with your payment autonomously. Wait for our office intervention; you'll receive an email enabling you to the payment.
- Pay the 1st instalment on your MyUniTO account through PagoPA by 21th October 2021 at 3:00 p.m. (Italian time)
- 6. Collect your smart card by following the instructions you'll receive by email.

*If you cannot recollect you past credentials, restore them! Click on *Ricordami la password* and strictly follow the available instructions. Please, DO NOT create another account!
