



# UNITA Virtual Mobility Call for students a.y. 25-26

**First application window: opening in June 2025**  
**Second application window: opening in December 2025**

## IMPORTANT NOTE

## Aims and main features

Selected students can:

- **Join up to two online courses** offered by the Universities of the [Alliance UNITA](#) and the [Geminae project](#)
- **Pass the final exam** of the selected courses
- **Obtain the ECTS** credits provided by the courses

This call does not contemplate physical mobility, nor the awarding of grants or scholarships to selected students.

# Participation requirements

- 1 – **Being regularly enrolled** (including part-time students) in a first-cycle, second/single-cycle, or third-cycle degree program at the University of Turin, consistently with the courses listed in the Virtual Mobility Catalogue
- 2 – **Having suitable activities available in your career plan**, such as:
  - **Courses** consistent with the course you will join in your Virtual Mobility
  - **Optional ECTS («Crediti a scelta»)**
  - **Item «Flexibility window» or activities not included in your study plan** (so-called additional exams, “esami in sovrannumero”), if your Degree programme allows it
- 3 – **Having the language proficiency and curricular requirements** of the chosen courses, as listed in the [Virtual Mobility Course Catalogue](#).

# ECTS Recognition

In order to recognize the ECTS obtained during the Virtual Mobility, selected students have to:

- consult with the [Coordinator for International Mobility of your degree programme](#) to **define the activities that will be eligible for recognition**
- **ensure that your career plan includes activities suitable for recognition** (refer to Slide 3). If necessary, update your plan to include such activities
- **Learning Agreement for Studies**, sign it, have it signed by the [Coordinator for International Mobility of your degree programme](#).

After the Virtual Mobility, submit the completed and signed Learning Agreement – After the Mobility section – and complete the UNITA online survey (a link will be provided).

# Application

Students can select up to 2 course in the [Virtual Mobility Course Catalogue](#).

Applications must be **submitted online** through the application form. The link to the application form is available on the [Virtual Mobility](#) webpage.

**ATTENTION:** Drafts or incomplete applications will not be accepted. The application must be sent from UniTo's institutional email address (xxx@edu.unito.it).

## Application deadline

The first application window's deadline is **Wednesday, July the 2<sup>o</sup> at 12 p.m.**

Applications submitted after the deadline will be accepted under no circumstance.

# Evaluation criteria - up to 100 points

**A - Academic results (maximum 70 points)** according to your student status and the exams registered in your career by **30/05/2025**:

**1. Students enrolled in a first cycle, second cycle, single cycle degree programme:**

A1. Evaluation of weighted average grade

A2. Evaluation of ECTS registered

**2. PhD Students**

Evaluation of latest graduation mark

**B – Additional points (maximum 30) to participants with fewer opportunities:**

disability (corresponding to at least 50%), refugee status, subsidiary protection, displaced persons, *careleavers* (art. 1, comma 250, Italian Law 205/2017), students endowed with EDISU scholarship, children of recipients of disability pensions, war orphans, civilian blind individuals, and those who are mutilated or disabled due to war, work, or service, as well as their children.

- **Candidates with disability and/or specific learning disability** must send the relevant disability certification to [ufficio.disabili@unito.it](mailto:ufficio.disabili@unito.it) or [ufficio.dsa@unito.it](mailto:ufficio.dsa@unito.it) before the deadline of the call.
- **Candidates with refugee status, subsidiary protection, displaced person status** must send their residence permit to [unita.students@unito.it](mailto:unita.students@unito.it) before the deadline of the call.



# Final ranking acceptance

The rankings will be published at: [www.unito.it](http://www.unito.it) > [Internazionalità](#) > [UNITA](#) > [Universitas Montium](#) > [UNITA Virtual Mobility](#).

Only eligible candidates will appear on the list, ranked by their score. After publication and confirmation from partner universities, the University of Turin will notify selected candidates via their institutional email (@edu.unito.it).

Students must accept or decline the offer within 5 calendar days from the publication date, following the provided instructions. Failure to confirm by the deadline will result in automatic exclusion.

Virtual mobility will only begin once accepted by the partner university, in line with the requirements of the [Virtual Mobility Course Catalogue](#) and the host institution's procedures.

Selected students must submit a *Learning Agreement for Virtual Mobility* signed by their [Coordinator for International Mobility of your degree programme](#). Digitally signed documents are accepted.
