COURSE SUMMARY

Data journalism is a data-driven form of journalism. Data are sources of information that can be gathered and analyzed using statistical methods and socio-economic models. Data should then be presented in an informative and engaging way, also using infographics, and tell a story. The laboratory is framed as follows.

1. WHAT IS DATA JOURNALISM. Introduction to data journalism; basic elements of journalism; history and development of data journalism; skills needed for the job and the lab.

2. DATA. Looking for the data; initial checks on the databases; replication and sources.

3. ANALISYS. Raw data; levels of the analysis and methods.

4. CRATING AN ARTICLE. Choice of the results to present; storytelling using graphic tools, words; roadmap to follow.

V. EDITORIAL OFFICE. Proposal, discussion, and topic assignment.
