OTHER ACTIVITIES BESIDES THE COURSE

The Visiting Professor will participate in seminars and research activities with members of the scientific disciplinary field and department members. Other activities that may be planned include workshops with students and participation through guest lectures in the teaching activities of colleagues.

VISITING PROFESSOR PROFILE

The visiting professor's field of expertise should be cultural philosophy with a specific focus on the intersection with philosophical anthropology and anthropology of media and techniques. In particular, the profile should have expertise on the problems of AI, philosophy of technique, philosophy of image, and anthropology (philosophical and historical). In specific, the profile should include:

- Ph.D. or equivalent in Philosophy, Cultural Studies, or a related field;
- Demonstrated expertise in Philosophical Anthropology, Philosophy of Technology, and Philosophy of Cultures.
- A record of academic research and publications in the field;
- Excellent teaching skills and experience in higher education;
- Ability to engage in interdisciplinary and collaborative research.
