#### **COURSE SUMMARY**

The teaching includes a description of different textual genres of written academic discourse, with an emphasis on the correct and conscious use of different discursive signals in Spanish. Short academic texts in Spanish will be analysed and written textual production exercises in academic Spanish will be carried out.

- 1. Characteristics of academic texts.
- 2. Exposition and argumentation in academic texts.
- 3. Discourse markers and their use in academic texts.

This course aims to:

- develop and consolidate the ability to distinguish between written academic genres;

- develop the ability to write short academic texts in Spanish;
- enable students to acquire the basic tools for analyzing academic texts written in Spanish;
- improve competence in the use of Spanish discourse markers according to their functions.
