COURSE SUMMARY

Critical analysis of the main teaching methodologies developed in the language teaching research, also in reference to the specific role of the teacher, to the conceptual, epistemological and didactic nodes of language teaching and learning.

Design and development of language teaching activities: illustration of the principles and methodologies for the construction of activities and more generally a language teaching curriculum. The use of ICT in language teaching and learning.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- a) Knowledge and understanding: students must know the main teaching methodologies developed in the language teaching research.
- b) Ability to apply knowledge and understanding: students must be able to design and develop teaching activities using the principles and methodologies typical of language teaching.
- c) Making judgments: students must be able to identify and classify errors of interference, of analogy, of overextension.

d) Communication skills: students must be able to discuss syllabuses, to clearly and effectively explain the main rules that govern the language, and the characteristics of mistakes made by learners.

e) Learning skills: students must be able to orient themselves in the bibliography and to deepen theoretical and practical elements.
