COURSE SUMMARY

The course will analyse the main Italian and international events of the 20th Century, focusing on their socio-economical dimension as well as their political, institutional and cultural facets. The lectures will cover the period until the end of the Twentieth century, examining the defining issues of democracy, nation-state, imperialism, the World Wars, totalitarian dictatorships, the Cold War, the decolonisation and the globalisation.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

The aim of the course is to provide students with a basic knowledge of the main international historical transformations since the late nineteenth century to the early 2000s.

VISITING PROFESSOR PROFILE

The Visiting Professor must have a high scientific profile within his/her national academic community and must also have developed significant experience at international level. He/she must have qualifications and publications in the field of contemporary history, with a focus on Italian history, European history, history of "cold war", history of sociality, history of leisure.
