LEARNING OBJECTIVES

The aims of the course are the following:

- the students should know the main theories on the development of inter-subjectivity;
- they should be able to analyze the cognitive, affective and social aspects of inter-subjectivity;
- they should be able to use theoretical analysis tools and to apply experimental, observational and clinical methods.

Specifically, the course will present a tool of evaluation of emotion understanding.

OTHER ACTIVITIES BESIDES THE COURSE

The visiting professor may also hold a seminar for doctoral students, and a lecture specifically dedicated to educators and teachers on development of the emotion understanding and their assessment.
