COURSE SUMMARY

The visiting professor will present the problems involved in health promotion and disease prevention in the community and will show the primary care managed by the pediatric nurse in the territory (i.e out of the hospital). The Italian and foreign country models will be compared.

The primary care and the different models adopted in different countries will be discussed.

A relevant part of the course will be focused on Transitional care, ie the transition of patients with chronic severe illness from pediatric to adult hospitals.

The problems due to dealing with families of different ethnicity and faith will also be discussed.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- To reach a good knowledge of the duties and responsabilities of pediatric nurse both in hospital and home patient care
- To understand the cultural diversity of different populations in healthcare
- To define the nurse's role in Primary Care and Transitional Care models

The visiting professor will held a seminar addressed to MD of the specialisation school in pediatrics describing the duties and the responsabilities of the pediatric nurse in the hospital setting in his/her country.
