COURSE SUMMARY

The Visiting Professor will share the course wih a teacher of the National Public Health System.

The Italian teacher will present the duties and the responsibilities of the pediatric nurse mainly in the hospital setting.

The Visiting Professor will concentrate on the problems involved in health promotion and disease prevention in the community and will show the primary care managed by the pediatric nurse in the territory (i.e. out of the hospital). The Italian and foreign country models will be compared.

A relevant part of the course will be focused on Transitional care, i.e. the transition of patients with chronic severe illness from pediatric to adult hospitals. Different models adopted in different countries will be discussed.

The problems due to dealing with families of different ethnicity and faith will also be discussed.

To understand the cultural diversity of different populations in healthcare.

To define the nurse's role in Primary Care and Transitional Care models.
