The course will focus on one or more of the following topics, according to the visiting professor's specific skills:

- global climate politics and policies
- participatory approaches
- grassroots and social movements
- development & migration nexus
- urbanization and megacities in the Global South
- Large-scale infrastructure and dams
- WASH approaches
- land grab and resource extractivism
- conservation and protection of biodiversity
- financial mechanism for development
- ICT4D

#### **LEARNING OBJECTIVES**

The students will:

- a) Understand the international cooperation debate;
- b) Develop critical thinking on theories, policies and practices that are reflected in cooperation programs (critical theoretical knowledge skills);
- c) Acquire familiarity with scientific journals and published research in this field (critical knowledge skills);
- d) Recognize the political debate on international cooperation.

The visiting professor will be required to hold a research seminar for the Department and a dissemination conference open to students and citizens.

- In-depth experience in analyzing development cooperation projects involving community-based organizations and Indigenous people;
- in-depth experience in teaching development and post-development studies in University courses. The above research experience in the field of development studies and international cooperation for development must be substantiated by relevant publications in international journals.
