COURSE SUMMARY

The course aims to illustrate the approach of disability critical race studies in education. Starting from the concept of intersectionality, the teaching analyses the interdependencies between racism and ableism and offers elements to critically address the prejudice and oppressions faced by historically marginalised people.

At the end of the course, the students will be able to understand in depth the concept of intersectionality, to recognise structural inequalities within a school or educational context. They will have elements to act more consciously in combating ableism and racism.
