COURSE SUMMARY

General and specialized electronic dictionaries of the Spanish language: creation, use and dissemination. The language model and varieties. The pan-Hispanic perspective. Electronic corpora in the Spanish language (CORPES, PRESEEA, etc.). Contrasting new methodologies with dictionaries and lexicographical works. The use of online lexicographical resources to write short academic and scientific texts in Spanish.

Written and oral expression. The system and the norm. Norms and the notion of error. Linguistic reflection based on mistakes made. Feedback and ways of correcting written and oral texts in academic and journalistic Spanish. The correction of copies of academic and journalistic discursive genres.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

1. Know and consciously employ in one's own texts the lexicographical resources available online for the Spanish language.

2. To value the linguistic diversity of the Spanish language.
3. Acquire strategies for the identification of errors, feedback and correction of academic and journalistic written and oral texts.
