COURSE SUMMARY

The course will explore the organization of organs and systems by integrating both topographic and systematic approaches. It will cover details of the anatomy of the respiratory, digestive, endocrine, urinary, and reproductive systems, as well as the anatomy of the eye and ear. The course will include frontal lessons, Anatoage practical sessions, and microscopy training to enhance hands-on learning.
