# **COURSE SUMMARY**

The Laboratory of Religious Studies is a mandatory component for students enrolled in the MA in Religious Studies. It serves as a platform to explore key issues related to the study of religions and their potential applications in professional contexts. The laboratory provides an opportunity to engage with topics and experiences that complement the knowledge acquired in other courses. Classes will address fundamental methodological issues in the study of religions, with a particular focus on recent scholarship, including the significant contributions of Jonathan Z. Smith and Bruce Lincoln to the discipline.

### **LEARNING OBJECTIVES**

The objectives of the laboratory include enhancing knowledge and understanding of topics within the field of the History of Religions, developing research and analytical skills in one or more areas of religious studies, fostering independent judgment and critical argumentation in the study of religion, and cultivating the use of precise language and discipline-specific vocabulary. Students will

actively participate in lectures through shared readings, short oral presentations, and collective discussions.
