COURSE SUMMARY

The Laboratory of Greek History aims to offer students of the course of studies in Historical Sciences the opportunity to carry out a research exercise in Greek History within the more general framework of the topic to which the Lab is dedicated. In 2025/6 it will be devoted to the exegesis of the ancient sources (historiographic, literary and epigraphic, etc.), through the development of case studies significant to the history of ancient Greece, including Western, preferably in the classical age, but not exclusively.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

The seminar teaching has the aim of providing an effective working environment for understanding, deepening and finally applying firsthand practices and methodologies proper to specialized research in the field of Greek History and the presence of a foreign colleague will allow contact with different approaches to research, different methodologies and themes, leading to an enrichment of students' studies.

OTHER ACTIVITIES BESIDE THE COURSE

At least one dissemination conference open to the entire community will also be planned.
