The candidate must possess in-depth knowledge of the Food Safety Management System, as well as GHP, GMP, Prerequisites, and Operational Prerequisites. The candidate should have advanced expertise in the research, teaching, and study of major foodborne pathogens (e.g., Salmonella, Listeria monocytogenes, E. coli STEC, etc.), including their distribution within key food supply chains, as well as the development and application of antimicrobial strategies to mitigate and control these pathogens in various food products and processing environments.
