### **COURSE SUMMARY**

The course includes a description of the main anatomical and pathological lesions that can be found during a forensic veterinary necropsy. The basics for performing a forensic necropsy correctly will be provided, as well as the ability to distinguish lesions caused by sharp instruments, blunt objects, and starvation.

### **LEARNING OBJECTIVES**

The objectives of the course are to provide students with the necessary foundations to conduct a correct anatomic-pathological analysis, produce a report that can be used in court, and defend their conclusions.

### **OTHER ACTIVITIES BESIDE THE COURSE**

During the laboratory sessions, all the concepts taught in the course will be applied through simulations of crimes and injuries. Students will be expected to follow the case from the retrieval of the body to the final report.
