First steps



Available Services

By means of the support services provided and managed by the Office for Students with disabilities and SLD, UniTo seeks to meet the different needs of students with disabilities for attendance and academic success.

Based on your specific needs, we can:

- Support you in your initial adaptation to the university environment, including by meeting and exchanging with other students. We can support you in getting to know the facilities, the university websites, the organisation of your course of study, etc.
- bring you together with other senior students with SLD (peer-to-peer tutors) to discuss the best study strategies for your first exams.

- support you in your teaching activities through peer tutors, who can help you, for example, in lessons to take notes, when preparing for examinations, when dealing with bureaucratic procedures (career plan, Edumeter, etc.), etc..
- encourage your autonomy in studying through specific compensatory software, which are available at the office.
- allow you, in collaboration with the UniTo Libraries, to make use of texts in accessible format (in the case of dyslexia).
- propose other types of intervention, in case of particular difficulties.
- encourage, together with the other University staff, your active dialogue with the lecturers to define any teaching and examination methods adjustments.
- if you intend to take part in Erasmus+ projects, we can, together with the relevant departments, help you to present your requirements to the host university and ascertain the possible services from which you will benefit. You may also apply for additional special needs funding; more information can be found on the Erasmus+ for people with disabilities/special needs page.

For information you can always contact the Students with Disabilities and SLD Office.

Reference roles

The University of Turin offers students with SLD several kinds of listening and discussion.

In addition to contacting the Office for Students with Disabilities and SLD, the University also has:

- The Rector's Delegate for the inclusion of students with SLD, a political role with the function of coordinating and monitoring actions concerning the inclusion of students with SLD in the University.
- The Departmental Contact Person for the inclusion of students with SLD, who supports colleagues and students in defining possible adaptations to teaching methods.

 The Board for the Promotion of the Inclusion of Students with Disabilities and Students with SLD, a University body in which representatives of the teaching, technical-administrative and student body (including students with disabilities and with SLD) take part.
